A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF TRACTS OF LAND MORE FULLY DESCRIBED HEREIN AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF THE APPROPRIATE DEEDS OF DEDICATION WITH THE RECORDER OF DEEDS OFFICE IN AND FOR YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, as part of the Final Subdivision for Stonewicke, which plan is recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, in and for York County, Pennsylvania, Phase I in Plan Book 2484, Page 3377, and Phase II in Plan Book 2540, Page 813 (the "Plan"), the Plan required the offer of dedication of certain streets and sanitary sewer lines, more specifically described herein, which streets and sanitary sewer lines and rights-of-way are now being offered for dedication by Stonewicke LP; and

The tracts of land as described in the attached Exhibit "A" and as set forth in the Deed of Dedication-Sewer by and between Stonewicke LP and PENN TOWNSHIP.

The tracts of land as described in the attached Exhibit "B" and as set forth in the Deed of Dedication (Fee Simple) by and between Stonewicke LP and PENN TOWNSHIP.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Deeds of Dedication attached hereto are hereby received and accepted by Penn Township as effectively transferring to said Township the said tracts of land more fully described in the attached exhibits and as set forth on the descriptions contained in the aforesaid Deeds.
